deposited in the savings account bearing
no.30313991334 of the petitioner and a sum of

No.134828 dated 22.05.2014. therefore, the order of
the Hon’ble Court has been complied with.”



That being so, now no further indulgence is called for in this contempt application

It is further reported that petitioner has expired on 14.5.2016.

If that be so, and if the legal heirs of the original petitioner Mr. Ashish Kumar Jha, have any grievance still subsisting, they shall have liberty to claim it afresh in accordance with law.
