Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Petitioner seeks bail in KMP (Kazimohammadpur)

P.S. Case No.379 of 2018 registered for the offences
punishable under Sections 302, 201, 120(B) and 34 of the
Indian Penal Code.

Informant is father of the deceased who has stated in
his written complaint that his son, Pankaj Kumar, was an
employee of Bhawani hospital for the last six months and had
gone to work on 28.08.2018 along with his cousin brother Ajit
Kumar but in the evening it was informed that his son, Pankaj
Kumar, is missing and on 30.08.2018 his dead body was
recovered from the premises of the hospital and on the basis of
suspicion he has named four persons as the accused including



the petitioner.

One of the employees Pankaj Kumar of the hospital confessed his involvement in crime and has named three more accused and their complicity. However, in such confession, name of the petitioner is not there. Petitioner has got no criminal antecedent and is in custody since 02.09.2018.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner named above be released on bail upon furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Muzaffarpur in connection with KMP (Kazimohammadpur) P.S. Case No. 379 of 2018 with following conditions:-

- (1) Bailors should be local having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the court concerned.
- (2) Petitioner shall co-operate in the trial and shall be represented on each and every date fixed by the court.
- (3) If the petitioner tampers with the evidence or the witnesses of the case, in that case, prosecution will be at liberty to



move for cancellation of bail of
the petitioner.
