Petitioner seeks bail in **Sitamarhi Official**
Complaint Case No.C2/488/18 instituted for the offence under
Section(s) 30(a) of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

It is alleged that 45 litres Nepali Saufi wine has been
recovered from possession of the petitioner.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is in
custody since 17.09.2018 having clean antecedents.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, prayer of
the petitioner for grant of bail is allowed. Let the petitioner,
above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of
Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount



each to the satisfaction of the **ADJ II cum Special Judge, Excise Act, Sitamarhi**, in connection with **Sitamarhi Official Complaint Case No.C2/488/18**, subject to the condition that both the bailors shall be close relative of the petitioner.
