ORAL ORDER

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Petitioner seeks bail in Rajgir P.S. Case No.294 of 2018 registered for the offence punishable under Sections 20, 22 of the N.D.P.S. Act.

Allegation is recovery of 75 gram Ganja from Gumti (shop) of the petitioner.

It has been submitted that petitioner is not engaged in selling Ganja but the informant recovered the said Gana from somewhere else and implicated the petitioner in this case merely on suspicion. It has further been submitted that the said Ganja is below the minimum quantity. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent and he is in custody since 05.10.2018.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of



the case, let the petitioner named above be released on bail upon furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned District and Sessions Judge, Nalanda at Bihar Sharif in connection with Rajgir P.S. Case No.294 of 2018, with following conditions:-

(1) Bailors should be local having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the court concerned.

(2) Petitioner shall co-operate in the trial and shall be properly represented on each and every date fixed by the court and shall remain physically present as directed by the Court and his absence on two consecutive dates without sufficient reason, his bail bond shall be cancelled by the court below.

(3) If the petitioner tampers with the evidence or the witnesses of the case, in that case, prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail of the petitioner.
