ORAL ORDER

2 13-12-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

Petitioner, who is in custody, seeks bail in connection with Sursand P.S. Case No. 187 of 2018 registered for the offence punishable under Sections 392 and 411 of the Indian Penal Code.

Informant has alleged that while he was going to catch train on his motorcycle, he was intercepted by four miscreants boarded on two motorcycles and snatched away on the strength of arms Rs. 1,10,000/-, mobile with sim and fled away. FIR is against unknown. The name of petitioner has surfaced in this case on the basis of confession made by co-accused Gunjan Kumar Mishra and Sunny Kumar, except said confession there is no other incriminating material against



petitioner. Similarly placed co-accused persons, namely Sunil Kumar, Gunjan Kumar Mishra and Sunny Kumar have been granted bail by a co-ordinate Bench of this Hon'ble Court vide order dated 02.11.2018 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 66426 of 2018, order dated 03.12.2018 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 70227 of 2018 and order dated 03.12.2018 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 69928 of 2018. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent and he is in custody since 26.09.2018.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner named above be released on bail upon furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate, Pupri, Sitamarhi, in connection with Sursand P.S. Case No. 187 of 2018 subject to the conditions that:-

(1) Bailors should be local having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the court concerned.

(2) Petitioner shall co-operate in the trial and shall be properly represented on each and every date fixed by the court and his absence on two consecutive dates without proper and sufficient reason the trial court will be at liberty to cancel his bail bond.

(3) If the petitioner tampers with the evidence or the witnesses of the case, in that case, prosecution will be at



liberty to move for cancellation of bail
of the petitioner.
