APP representing the State.

Petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in connection with Sheikhpura (Hathiyawan) P.S. Case No. 708 of 2018 registered for the offences punishable under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner in the present case has been implicated on the basis of confessional statement made by one Ajit Chaudhary from whose possession the illicit liquor was recovered. Learned counsel submits that the petitioner has got no criminal history, but even in absence of any recovery from his possession, his name has been brought in the present case.

Learned APP for the State is present and has opposed



the prayer for bail.

In the given facts and circumstances, in case of arrest or surrender of the petitioner within a period of four weeks from today, the abovenamed petitioner shall be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.15,000/- (rupees fifteen thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned 1st Additional District and Sessions Judge, Sheikhpura in connection with Sheikhpura (Hathiyawan) P.S. Case No. 708/18 (Excise Case No.286/18), subject to the condition that petitioner shall join the investigation by reporting to the Investigating Officer within a period of three weeks from today and shall cooperate in course of investigation, failing which the Investigating Officer shall be at liberty to take steps for cancellation of his bail bond. This will be in addition to condition prescribed under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
