ORAL ORDER

3 14-12-2018 Heard learned counsel for petitioner and learned counsel for the State.

Petitioner, who is in custody, seeks bail in connection with N.T.P.C. P.S. Case No. 41 of 2018 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 384, 386, 387, 504 and 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Informant has alleged that two unknown miscreants overpowering them on the strength of pistol snatched away Rs. 8,000/- from his pocket.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that he is innocent and has committed no offence. He has been falsely implicated in this case only on the basis of his self-confession and was remanded in this case on 07.08.2018.



Except his self-confession there is nothing against him.

Considering the aforesaid fact and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner named above be released on bail upon furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bhagalpur, in connection with N.T.P.C. P.S. Case No. 41 of 2018, subject to conditions:

- (1) Bailors should be local having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the court concerned.
- (2) Petitioner shall co-operate in the trial and shall be properly represented on each and every date fixed by the court and shall remain physically present as directed by Court and his absence on two consecutive dates without sufficient reasons, his bail bond shall be cancelled by the court below.
- (3) If the petitioner tampers with the evidence or the witnesses of the case, in that case, prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail of the petitioner.
