Appellant herein Ram Sewak Singh has filed this
appeal calling in question his conviction ordered by the 1st Additional
Sessions Judge, Begusarai in Sessions Trial No.332 of 1993/2 of 1993
and convicting him to undergo life imprisonment for offence under
Section 302/34 of the I.P.C.

Considering the fact that when the judgment was
pronounced in the year 1995 Ram Sewak Singh was already more
than 60 years of age, on 29.3.2018 we had requested the counsel
