ORAL ORDER

2 05-04-2018 Heard the parties.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with Sahpur P.S.Case no.182 of 2017, registered for offences punishable under Sections 368, 365, 385, 504 and 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the petitioner is of abduction of the husband of the informant with a view to get the sale-deed executed by him.

Submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner is that statement of the victim has been recorded under Section 164 Cr.P.C., which is Annexure 2 and that clearly falsify the prosecution case.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.



Having heard both sides and in view of the facts and circumstances, as stated above , let the petitioner, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of six weeks from the date of order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned A.C.J.M., Danapur in connection with Sahpur P.S.Case nO.182 of 2017, subject to condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

With following conditions :

- (i) One of the bailors of the petitioner shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned court.
- (ii) The petitioner will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence.
- (iii) The petitioner shall co-operate in the investigation of the case and make himself available as and when required by the Police, otherwise, the prosecution is free to move for cancellation of his bail bond.

With the aforesaid observation, this application is allowed.
