2 05-04-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, counsel appearing
on behalf of the State.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with
Pakaridayal P.S. Case No.69 of 2016 registered under Sections
341, 323, 325, 354, 379 of the Indian Penal Code.

The incident took place on account of dispute over partition
of the land. Petitioner No.1 is the father of the informant,
petitioner No.2 is the brother of the informant and petitioner No.3
is the sister-in-law of the informant.

Consider the background of dispute and the fact that the
petitioner No.1 is the father of the informant, petitioner No.2 is the



brother of the informant and petitioner No.3 is sister-in-law of the informant, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt / production of a copy of this order are directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate Vth, Motihari in connection with Pakaridayal P.S. Case No.69 of 2016, subject to conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
