Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with Agiaon Bazar P.S. Case No. 10/2018, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 341/323/307/504/506/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that these two petitioners have no specific role to play and they have been named only on account of their presence at the place of occurrence. It is further submitted that the main allegation is against Rupesh Singh and not these two petitioners.

Considering the facts and circumstances and because of the fact that these two petitioners are not having any criminal



antecedent, let the petitioners in the event of their arrest / surrender within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the each amount to the satisfaction of the learned C.J.M., Bhojpur at Ara, in connection with Agiaon Bazar P.S. Case No. 10/2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
