ORAL ORDER

2 11-04-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the State.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in **Darbhang**
Town P.S. Case No. 218 of 2017 instituted for the offence under Sections 341, 323, 307, 504, 354, 379, 427 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is alleged in the written report that these petitioners assaulted the informant and his wife Puja Devi on account of altercation as alleged in the written report.

The injury report has been enclosed as Annexure-2 which shows that injury found on the person of the informant and



his wife was simple in nature.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that there is no any intention to assault which would appear from the injury report. It has further been submitted that altercation had taken place between the parties as earlier petitioners have made complaint against the informant and co-accused Vikas Sharan Sahu before the SSP for misbehaving with petitioner No. 4 and to save their skin the instant case has been filed.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners is allowed. In the event of surrender/arrest of the petitioners, named above, within six weeks from today, in connection with **Darbhanga Town P.S. Case No. 218 of 2017**, they shall be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of **learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Darbhanga**, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) Cr. P.C. with further conditions (1) bailors should be local having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the court concerned, (2) petitioners shall cooperate in the trial and shall be present on each and every date fixed by the court and their absence on two consecutive dates without proper and reasonable reason will be



liable to cancel their bail bond and (3) if petitioners tamper with the evidence or the witnesses of the case, in that case, prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail of the petitioners.
