ORAL ORDER

2 20-02-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned counsel for the State.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with **Ishipur(Barahat) P.S. Case No. 94 of 2017** registered for the offence punishable under Sections 366(A)/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Informant is the father of the victim girl, who in his FIR has stated that on 08.09.2017 at about 12 O' Clock in the night, petitioners entered into his house and took away his minor daughter Priyanka Kumari in order to solemnize marriage with his daughter. The girl was recovered and in her statement under Section 164 of the Cr.P.C, she has stated that due to scolding by his father, she went away to her maternal



grandmother's house and lived there for two and a half months and has not made any allegation against the petitioners.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioners named above be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned **Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-VIII, Bhagalpur** in connection with **Ishipur (Barahat) P.S. Case No. 94 of 2017** subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
