The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with Hisua P.S. Case No. 20 of 2018 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 341/323/504/307/506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Case No. 20 of 2018 , subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
