3 21-02-2018 Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the

learned APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in connection
with Amarpur P.S. Case No. 165 of 2017 for the offences
punishable under Sections 341, 323, 307, 379, 504/34 and 302 of
the Indian Penal Code.

After some arguments, the learned counsel for the
petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition with a
liberty to approach the learned trial court for grant of regular bail.

Accordingly, it is directed that in case the petitioner
surrenders before the concerned court in connection with Amarpur
P.S. Case No. 165 of 2017 within a period of two weeks from
today and applies for regular bail, the concerned court shall



consider and dispose of the prayer of the petitioner for grant of regular bail on the same day considering the fact that there is no fatal injury on the person of the deceased and the deceased is said to have died on account of septicemia toxemia and shock.

The petition is disposed of as withdrawn.
