In the present case, the petitioner is challenging the Force Order No. 20/05 contained in Memo No. 144 dated 17.1.2005, whereby and whereunder, though the petitioner was granted scale of Senior Selection Grade of Inspector with effect from 1.4.1981 but, without extending the financial benefit.

From the supplementary counter affidavit, it appears that during pendency of this application, the respondents have redressed the grievance of the petitioner and has issued Memo No. 2185 dated 25.7.2012, whereby and whereunder, the State has



extended the financial benefit to the petitioner from the date of enhancement of scale in the Senior Selection Grade.

In that view of the matter, this writ application is dismissed as having become infructuous.
