2 05-04-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

The petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in a case instituted
for the offences under Sections 406 and 420 of the Indian
Penal Code.

Allegation has been made by the informant that he has
supplied 1682 bags of cement worth Rs.4,96,000/- on the
guarantee of the petitioner. Defence has been taken that cement
was supplied to his son who is running the business but later
on son of the petitioner died. Now petitioner has paid all
outstanding dues from the retrial dues which he has received
and in token of that he has produced the receipt showing
payment of the money.



Looking to the facts and circumstances of the case, in the event of arrest or surrender within four weeks from today, let petitioners, namely, Md. Shamshad Khan @ Shamshad Khan, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Sherghati at Gaya in connection with Imamganj P.S. Case No.12 of 2017, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
