ORAL ORDER

2 10-04-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned counsel for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with Dumraon P.S. Case No.19 of 2018 for allegedly having committed the offence under Sections 147, 148, 149, 307, 427, 212, 186, 353, 427 and 120B of the Indian Penal Code and Section 3 of Damage to Public Property Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that frivolous case has been lodged against the petitioner only because he is having adjoining land near the place of occurrence where the cavalcade of the Chief Minister has been stoned. Save and except the said allegation, there is nothing on record to implicate the petitioner.



Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned counsel for the State, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Buxar, in connection with Dumraon P.S. Case No.19 of 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
