Inter alia contending that admission of those doctors who are M.D. in Radiotherapy in D.M. Medical Oncology is bad and if doctors who are M.D. in Radiotherapy are permitted to treat Cancer patients and carry out Chemotherapy, it would be disastrous and harmful to the Cancer patients and making certain grievances with regard to unqualified persons being permitted to sit in the Cancer Hospitals, this writ petition has been filed.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties, we find that the issue involved in the matter is a technical issue and



we are not equipped with such an expertise to decide the issue.

Granting liberty to the petitioner to approach the respondents, we dispose of the matter.

In case the petitioner has filed a representation before the respondents, respondents to examine it at their own end, decide it in accordance with law and communicate their decision to the petitioner within a period of three months.
