ORAL ORDER

2 21-02-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case for
the offence registered under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition
and Excise Act, 2016.

The prosecution story, in brief, is that total 26.200
liters wine is said to have been recovered.

It has been submitted by learned counsel for the
petitioner that the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. There
is no allegation of tampering with the witnesses alleged against the
petitioner. The petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present
case. It is alleged that total 26.200 liters wine is recovered from



the shop which is situated in the premises of the petitioner. The name of the petitioner has come on the basis of alleged recovery made from the shop which is situated in premises of the petitioner. There is no compliance of Section 100 Cr. P.C.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R/ Complaint Case.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner above named, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Special Judge (Excise), Additional Sessions Judge-4th, Kaimur at Bhabua, in connection with Tr. No./Excise Case No. 1912 of 2017, P.R. 162, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
