2 27-02-2018 Heard both sides.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in Ganga Bridge
P.S. Case No.121 of 2017 registered under Sections 379, 411 of
the Indian Penal Code and Section 4/40(8)(d) of the Bihar Minor
Mineral Concession Rule, 1972 and Sections 3 and 8(d) of the
Bihar Mineral Illegal Mining Transportation Storage Prevention
Act, 2003.

The informant alleged that many tractors, boats and
sand were seized. The petitioner is said to be the owner of the
tractor.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is owner of BR 31 GA-5998. It is submitted that sand



was not loaded on the tractor of the petitioner.

Considering the facts aforesaid and the nature of allegation made against the petitioner and the fact that the petitioner is owner of one of the seized tractors, the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Vaishali at Hajipur in connection with Ganga Bridge P.S. Case No.121 of 2017, subject to conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
