of with a liberty to the petitioner to file representation before the District Programme Officer (Establishment), Vaishali who shall examine the claim of the petitioner for payment of the salary for the period petitioner has actually worked.

The District Programme Officer (Establishment) Vaisali (Replacement of the district Superintendent of Education) is directed to examine the claim of the petitioner and pass appropriate order in accordance with law on the issue of payment of salary preferably within four months from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order.

With the aforesaid, the writ petition stands disposed of.
