As none appeared on behalf of the petitioner the matter was passed over for a few cases. However, on repeat call the petitioner was again not represented.

2. The present writ petition has been filed for quashing the letter dated 09.09.2011 issued by the Sub-Divisional Officer, Narkatiaganj, West Champaran by which the petitioner has been directed to deposit an amount of Rs. 2,23,282.60 towards undistributed food grains lifted under the SGRY Scheme.

Learned counsel for the respondents appears and states that pursuant to the orders of this Court, the Enquiry Commission headed by Hon'ble Mr. Justice Uday Sinha (Retired) has now submitted its report and any further action in relation to recovery of the value of undistributed rice under the SGRY Scheme would abide by the decision



of the State Government to be taken on the basis of such report.

4. Having regard to the stand of the respondents, the writ petition stands disposed of.
