2 27-02-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with
Sadar Mahila P. S. Case No. 08 of 2016 registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 406/34 of the Indian Penal
Code and Sections 3 / 4 of Dowry Prohibition Act.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner
submits that in this case co-accused Firoj Ali and Rehana
Khatoon having similar allegation have been allowed pre-arrest
bail vide Cr. Misc. No. 28910 of 2016 by another co-ordinate
Bench of this Court and as such the petitioner deserves
sympathetic consideration.

Learned APP fairly submits that two co-accused have been
allowed pre-arrest bail.



In the facts and circumstances stated above, the petitioner above named, in case of his arrest or surrender within four weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, is directed to be released on bail on execution of bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned C.J.M., Aurangabad in connection with Aurangabad Sadar Mahila P. S. Case No. 8 of 2016, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
