Heard.

The petitioners apprehend arrest in connection with Goh P.S.Case No.29 of 2018 registered for an offence under Section 307 and other sections of the IPC.

The allegation as per FIR is that on 15.02.2018 when the informant was waiting for a vehicle, these petitioners along with ten dragged the informant and brutally assaulted him.

It has been submitted that it was the informant and his men who brutally assaulted the petitioners for which the petitioners lodged Goh P.S.Case No.30 of 2018. The informant himself is an accused in Goh P.S.Case No.31 of 2018 which was lodged by local police for causing hindrance in police administration. The injury report annexed with this application shows that the informant sustained three injuries which are simple in



nature.

The learned APP opposed the submissions.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, prayer for anticipatory bail is allowed. Let the above named petitioners in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within six weeks from today be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of SDJM, Daudnagar, Aurangabad in connection with Goh P.S.Case No.29 of 2018 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.

- (i) One of the bailors of the petitioners shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned Court.
- (ii) The petitioners will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence.
- (iii) The petitioners shall cooperate in the disposal of trial and make themselves available as and when required by the court and on the event of failure on his part to appear before the court below on two consecutive dates without showing any genuine reasons, the prosecution is free to move for cancellation of his bail.
