and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest
in a case registered for the offences punishable under
Section 376,511, 354 (R), 323 of the Indian Penal Code.

By order dated 16.11.2016, this Court
had refused prayer for anticipatory bail on merit, though
no one had appeared on behalf of the petitioner to assist
