ORAL ORDER

4 26-06-2018 The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in connection with Kargahar (Badahari O.P.) P.S. Case No. 81 of 2018, registered for offences punishable under Sections 341, 323, 504, 506, 406, 420 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the petitioners that they have received part payment of Rs. 4 lac for execution of sale deed with respect to four kathas of land from the informant but the sale deed of the land has not been executed in favour of the informant.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioners that they have falsely been made accused in this case and there is no agreement to show that the petitioners have taken the consideration money. Moreover, the case is purely of civil nature.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.

Having heard both sides, in view of the above facts, let the petitioners above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of six weeks from



the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bond of Rs. 25,000 (Rs. Twenty Five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned ACJM, Rohtas at Sasaram, in connection with Kargahar (Badahari O.P.) P.S. Case No. 81 of 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C, as well as subject to the following conditions, it is further subject to the condition that:-

- (i) One of the bailors of the petitioners shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned Court.
- (ii) The petitioners shall cooperate in the investigation and make themselves available as and when required by the police and on the event of failure on their part to appear before the police on two consecutive dates without showing any genuine reasons, the prosecution is free to move for cancellation of their bail bonds.
