Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the State.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in **Jamalpur P.S.**

Case No.176 of 2017 instituted for the offence under Sections 302/34
of the Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

It is alleged in the written report that the informant
received information that his son Pritam Kumar Tapaswi was murdered
near Bajrangbali. On getting information, he along with his wife came
to Jamalpur and identified the dead body of his son. The informant
raised suspicion against the petitioners and other accused persons.

Case diary has been received.

The learned APP after looking into the case diary has
submitted that besides suspicion there is no allegation of specific overt
act against the petitioners.



Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners is allowed. In the event of surrender/arrest of the petitioners, named above, within six weeks from today, in connection with **Jamalpur P.S. Case No.176 of 2017 (G.R. No. 2707 of 2017)**, they shall be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned **Chief Judicial Magistrate, Munger**, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) Cr. P.C. with further conditions (1) bailors should be local having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the court concerned, (2) petitioners shall cooperate in the trial and shall be present on each and every date fixed by the court and their absence on two consecutive dates without proper and reasonable reason will be liable to cancel their bail bond and (3) if petitioners tamper with the evidence or the witnesses of the case, in that case, prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail of the petitioners.
