2. 02-07-2018 The sole petitioner, apprehending his arrest in
Rasulpur P.S. Case No. 32 of 2018 registered for offence under

On perusal of the F.I.R., it is evident that there is
specific accusation against the petitioner for giving assault on
the head of the informant causing injury.

the prayer for anticipatory bail.
