APP for the State.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in a case registered under Sections 498A, 304B, 201/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation is that the accused persons including the petitioners committed murder of the daughter of the informant due to non-fulfilment of demand of dowry.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioners that the petitioners have got no criminal antecedent. There is no allegation of tampering of witnesses alleged against the petitioners. The petitioners have falsely been implicated in the present case. The petitioners are mother-in-law and the Gotani



of the deceased. The husband of the deceased is in custody.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioners are named in the complaint case/F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of arrest/surrender before the learned court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M., Benipatti, Madhubani in connection with Benipatti P.S. case No.186 of 2017, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
