Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned A.P.P. for the State.

This is an application for grant of anticipatory bail in
connection with Bhagwanpur PS case no. 105 of 2017 registered for the
offences punishable under Section 366A/34 of Indian Penal Code.

The allegation is regarding one Manish Kr. Sahni
having apprehended the victim girl and committed rape on her.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is the brother-in-law of the said Manish Kr. Sahni and the
victim girl, in her statement under Section 164 of Code of Criminal
Procedure, has not leveled any allegation whatsoever against the
petitioner herein. It is further submitted that the petitioner has got no
role to play in the alleged incident and he has a clean antecedent.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the



case, I deem it fit and appropriate to admit the petitioner to the privilege of anticipatory bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender within six weeks from the date of receipt/ production of a copy of this order before the court below on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Begusarai in connection with Bhagwanpur PS case no. 105 of 2017 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of Code of Criminal Procedure.
