This writ petition has been filed by the petitioner challenging the order dated 10.03.2016 passed by the Collector, Kaimur in Encroachment Appeal Case No. 05 of 2015-16 by which the appeal preferred by him against the notice issued by the Anchal Adhikari, Rampur on 07.08.2015 for removal of encroachment from the shop in question has been dismissed.



2. At the outset, it has been brought to the notice of this Court that during the pendency of the writ petition, the respondents directed the petitioner to vacate the premises till 06.04.2016 and, subsequently, the alleged encroachment has also been removed.
