ORAL ORDER

10 28-08-2018 The nature of the grievance raised in the present writ application seems to be in the nature of a Public Interest Litigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner admits that in this very matter the petitioner has filed a Public Interest Litigation which is pending consideration before the Hon'ble Division Bench of this Court.

In the opinion of this Court, if the Public Interest Litigation in this very matter is pending and the grievance of the



petitioner is connected with the same, considering the nature of the grievance, this Court sitting singly in its writ jurisdiction would not be the appropriate Court to entertain the grievance of the petitioner which is in the nature of a Public Interest Litigation. He can agitate all such pleas, which he is taking here, in the Public Interest Litigation or in an appropriate proceeding, as may be advised.

The application stands disposed off accordingly.
