ORAL ORDER

2 23-07-2018 The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection
with Bettiah Town P.S. Case No. 504 of 2017, registered for
offences punishable under Sections 504, 506, 384/34 of the Indian
Penal Code.

Allegation against the petitioner is of demand of *rangdari*
of Rs. 2 lacs from the informant, who happens to be Revenue
Official, on phone.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that in
fact the informant has taken Rs. 38,000/- for the mutation of his
land and also kept the sale deed and when the petitioner
pressurized the informant, he came out with this false case.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.

Having heard both sides, in view of the above facts, let
the petitioner above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender
before the court below within a period of six weeks from the date



of receipt/production of a copy of this order, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bond of Rs. 25,000 (Rs. Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned CJM, Bettiah, West Champaran, in connection with Bettiah Town P.S. Case No. 504 of 2017, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C, it is further subject to the condition that:-

- (i) One of the bailors of the petitioner shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned Court.
- (ii) The petitioner shall cooperate in the investigation and make himself available as and when required by the police and on the event of failure on his part to appear before the police on two consecutive dates without showing any genuine reasons, the prosecution is free to move for cancellation of his bail bonds.
