3 12-02-2018 Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned A.P.P. for the State.

This is an application for grant of anticipatory bail in connection with Tarapur P.S. Case No. 33 of 2016 registered for the offence punishable under Sections 420, 323, 504 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code.

The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner had taken a loan, however, the same was not returned by him.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has never taken any amount of loan.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, I deem it fit and proper to admit the petitioner herein to the privilege of anticipatory bail in the event of his arrest or



surrender before the court below within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned S.D.J.M., Munger in connection with Tarapur P.S. Case No. 33 of 2016 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
