2 18-08-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP
for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered under Sections 30/30A of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

The prosecution case, in short, is that 29.580 liters wine is recovered.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that there is no allegation of tampering of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. The name of the petitioner has transpired on the basis of disclosure made by the co-accused, Rahul Kumar. Except for this, there is no other substantive evidence to suggest the implication of the petitioner in this case. It is alleged that 29.580



liters wine is recovered from Rahul Kumar. Nothing incriminating has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner had no knowledge regarding the alleged incident. There is no compliance of Section 100 Cr.P.C.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of arrest/surrender before the learned court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned 2nd Additional Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge, Excise Act, Begusarai in connection with Teghra P.S. Case No. 21 of 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
