2 13-09-2018 Heard learned counsel for petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

Petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection
with Gwalpara (Arar O.P.) P.S. Case No. 62 of 2018 for the
offences registered under Sections 341, 323, 324, 307, 427, 379
and 504/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the petitioner is of assaulting
Nirmal Yadav by Farsa which caused injury on his head. Injury
report has been enclosed as Annexure-2 in which abrasion on
occipital area of head has been found. Petitioner has also
suffered injury. It has been submitted that he is innocent and has
committed no offence. It has been further submitted that he has
been falsely implicated in this case. There is case and counter
case between the parties. He has got no criminal antecedent.



Considering the facts and circumstances of the present case, let petitioner, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Sri Shiv Kumar, learned J.M.-1st Class, Uda-Kishunganj, Madhepura in connection with Gwalpara (Arar O.P.) P.S. Case No. 62 of 2018, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
