2 10-09-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP for
the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered
under Sections 147, 148, 323, 324, 341, 307, 379, 504, 506 of the
Indian Penal Code.

The allegation against the petitioner is that on the order of
Madan Singh, he assaulted the informant with Farsa.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the
petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. There is no allegation of
tampering of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. There is
admitted land dispute. There is case and counter case between the
parties. The petitioner's side also sustained injury and the said
injury has not been explained by the prosecution. Hence no



offence u/S 307 of the Indian Penal Code is made out.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the Complaint Case/F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of arrest/surrender before the learned court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Motihari, East Champaran in connection with Pipra P.S. Case No. 35 of 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
