matter and without going into the merits of the issue, respondent nos.3 and 4 are directed to look into the grievance, take note of the communication, Annexure-5 dated 24.05.2016 and to proceed to demarcate the area in question as is required in law and take action within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
