2      04-09-2018              The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection  
with Birpur P.S. Case No. 15 of 2018, registered for offences  
punishable under Sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 323, 504, 323, 307  
and 427 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the petitioner is that when police  
intercepted then petitioner and several other persons raised Hulla  
and tried to create obstacle and also attacked on police party.

Submission of learned counsel for the petitioner is that  
though the petitioner has been named in the F.I.R., but nothing  
specific has been attributed against the petitioner and he has  
falsely been implicated in this case.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.

Having heard both sides, considering the facts and



circumstances of the case, let the petitioner above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bond of Rs. 25,000 (Rs. Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, 1<sup>st</sup>, Begusarai, in connection with Birpur P.S. Case No. 15 of 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C, it is further subject to the condition that:-

- (i) One of the bailors of the petitioner shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned Court.
- (ii) The petitioner shall cooperate in the investigation and make himself available as and when required by the police and on the event of failure on his part to appear before the police on two consecutive dates without showing any genuine reasons, the prosecution is free to move for cancellation of his bail bonds.
