Accordingly, it is directed that the petitioners shall file a representation before the respondent no. 2 regarding their grievances raised in the writ petition within a period of two weeks from today and the respondent no.2 is directed to dispose off the same within a period of eight weeks thereafter considering the judgment rendered by the Hon'ble Apex Court reported in (2006) 4 SCC 1 (*Secretary State of Karnataka and Ors. Vs. Umadevi and*



Ors.) and (2010) 9 SCC 247 (State of Kamataka and Ors. Vs. M.L. Kesari and Ors.), by a reasoned and speaking order.

The writ petition is disposed off on the aforesaid terms.
