counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

Petitioner is apprehending arrest in connection with
Dinara P.S. Case No. 82 of 2018 for the offence under sections
406, 420, 467 and 468 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner has no criminal antecedent. He submits that the
amount collected was deposited. The mistake was committed by
the cashier of the Grahak Sewa Kendra.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has drawn attention
of this court to Annexure-2 to indicate that entire amount i.e. 6,
03,425/- has been deposited in the bank.



Considering the above, let the petitioner, named above, in the event of arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Vikramganj, Rohtas, in connection with Dinara P.S. Case No. 82 of 2018 subject to the condition as laid down under section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
