Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the respondent State.

Petitioner's counsel submits that it is his instruction that process has been initiated for selection of Sevika at Sahtola Anganbari Kendra, Centre no. 75. He submits that during earlier selection process he was debarred. His name was added in the electoral roll of ward no. 9 by mistake which has been rectified.
