7 10-10-2018 Learned counsel representing the Patliputra Central Co-operative Bank Limited has placed before this Court a Xerox-Copy of the order dated 11.05.2018 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Special Leave to Appeal (C) Nos. 10559-10560/2018. It appears that the Hon'ble Supreme Court has been pleased to stay the operation of the impugned judgment and order of this Court.
