The sole petitioner, apprehending his arrest in Saur  
Bazar P.S. Case No. 317 of 2018 registered for the offence  
under Section 7 of the Essential Commodities Act, 1955, has  
prayed for grant of bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender.

petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case.
