2 08-10-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Malsalami P.S. Case No. 258 of 2018 for the office
registered under Sections 380 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that on the
basis of pure suspicion, the petitioner has been implicated in
connection with the present case. It is further submitted that the
petitioner has no criminal antecedent and only because it is alleged
that he is used to peep through the window of his room at the
informant's room, it is alleged that he may have committed the
theft of the articles mentioned in the first information report.

Considering vague nature of allegation and that the
petitioner has no criminal antecedent, let the petitioner, above



named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of A.C.J.M., - II, Patna City in connection with Malsalami P.S. Case No. 258 of 2018, subject to the condition as laid under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
