ORAL ORDER

8 31-07-2018 Learned counsel for the petitioners informs the Court that grievance of the petitioner nos. 2 and 3 has been redressed and as such the present writ application is now confined to the writ petitioner no.1 as the writ petition on behalf of the petitioner nos. 2 and 3 has become infructuous.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the retirement of the petitioner nos. 1 and 2, the



petitioner no.1 may be given liberty to file fresh representation for redressal of his grievance before the Sanskrit Shiksha Board.

In view of the above, the writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner no.1 to file fresh representation before the Sanskrit Shiksha Board and the Sanskrit Shikhsa Board is required to decide the representation in accordance with law expeditiously preferably within a period of four months from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order.

With the aforesaid, the writ petition stands disposed of.
