2 07-12-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case
registered for the offences punishable under Sections
30(a)/38/41 of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

From the rented premise of *Santu Kumar* in the house
of the petitioner, recovery of liquor was there. Petitioner has got
no criminal antecedent.

Submission is that the raid was conducted after *Mr.*
Santu was found selling liquor, somewhere else.

Hence, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of
his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of
thirty days from the date of receipt of the order be released on
bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty



Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court below where the case is pending in connection with Jakkanpur Police Station Case No.293 of 2018, subject to conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure as well as condition that the petitioner shall fully co-operate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
