2 14-12-2018 Heard learned Counsel for the petitioner and the
learned APP for the State.

Petitioner apprehends arrest in Rajauli PS Case No.
238 of 2018 registered under Sections 386/34 of the IPC and
Section 30(A) of Bihar Prohibition & Excise Act, 2016.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that he has falsely
been implicated in this case on the alleged recovery of 750 ml of
wine from near the Rajauli bus stand. Nothing has been
recovered from the possession of the petitioner and the seizure
is not in accordance with Section 100 Cr.P.C. The petitioner has
no criminal antecedent.

Considering the aforesaid submissions as also the
facts and circumstances of the case, prayer for anticipatory bail
of the petitioner is allowed. In the event of his arrest or



surrender before the court below within four weeks from today,
let the petitioner above named be released on anticipatory bail
on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with
two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of
Additional Sessions Judge II -cum- Special Judge, Excise Act in
Rajauli PS Case No. 238 of 2018 subject to all conditions as
laid down in Section 438(2) of the Criminal Procedure Code.
