ORAL ORDER

2 13-12-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned APP for the State.

Petitioners apprehend arrest in Sheikhpura Police Station Case No 304 of 2016 registered under Sections 120B, 406, 420, 467, 468, 469 of Indian Penal Code.

It is submitted by Mr Purushottam Jha appearing for the petitioners that the petitioners have no concern with the allegations made in the first information report. Relying upon Annexure 2, the tenancy agreement between the Charitable Trust and the petitioners, he submits that the petitioners' only relation with the Trust is that of landlord and tenant and they have no concern with the Trust.



Considering the aforesaid submissions, prayer for anticipatory bail is allowed. In the event of their arrest or surrender before the Court within four weeks from today, the petitioners above named shall be released on bail on each of them furnishing bonds of Rs 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sheikhpura in Sheikhpura Police Station Case No 304 of 2016 subject to all conditions as laid down in Section 438 (2) of Criminal Procedure Code.
